Plans are in the works for our annual Skating Show, which will be produced by SQSA Parade. The theme of this year's show is "Where the Wild Things...are Skating!". Skaters who wish to participate must meet the following requirement:

1. Must be enrolled in Fall or Winter session classes of SportQuest Skating School or a contracting member in good standing of SQSA Parade. All ages and ability levels are welcome.
2. Please be present for all rehearsals. Remember, these are GROUP numbers and the success of the group depends on the effectiveness of the rehearsals. A detailed rehearsal schedule will be handed out in the beginning of March. Skaters who have missed too many rehearsals will either be eliminated from the number (no refunds) or will be asked to take a private lesson with the choreographer to learn the routine.

We also want to emphasize that these shows rely on volunteer effort. We need a commitment from each skater's parents to help with the show. A sign-up sheet will be posted in the lobby of the rink—PLEASE dive in and help! The ice show always creates a great sense of community at Parade. Your help is both greatly needed and greatly appreciated.
