
MADALYN MOREE PLACES 2nd IN USFS MIDWESTERN SECTIONALS ADVANCES TO NATIONALS

Maddy qualified for one of the 12 coveted Juvenile spots available at the 2014 USFS National Championships in Boston, January 5–12! She secured her spot by placing 2nd at Midwestern Sectionals with a score of 50.31 in November. Maddy had previously advanced to Sectionals with her stellar performance at Upper Great Lakes Regionals, where she placed 1st with a personal best score of 55.11! The Juvenile level was one of the most competitive this year. A total of 530 skaters competed in the 9 Regional Qualifiers hoping to advance. Annually, only 36 Juvenile skaters (the top four in each region) move on to Sectionals, and only 12 of those skaters (the top four in each of the 3 sections) advance to Nationals. **Congratulations Maddy!**



USFS National Championships run from Jan 5-12th. Maddy is currently scheduled to skate on Weds 1/8 at 1:00pm EST (12:00pm CST).

IZZI GOROWSKY WINS GRASSROOTS DIVISION FINALS MK YOUNG ARTISTS SHOWCASE (MKYAS4)

Izzi spent the summer immersed in the MKYAS4 online choreography competition. She choreographed 5 different programs, each having very specific requirements such as theme, music, style, artistic elements and footwork. She submitted videos of the programs to a panel of judges who provided feedback and selected winners for each challenge. Izzi placed 2nd overall in the Grassroots Division and won an all expenses paid trip to Washington DC to compete in the Finals on Dec 1 in front of a live audience!

For the Final challenge, Izzi was tasked with choreographing two programs: a solo that she skated, and a duet that renowned 'secret talent' skaters Kimmie Meissner and Adam Blake performed. The Finals took place during a live benefit ice show. The event boasted a long list of skating talent including guest skater Ryan Bradley, guest judge Michael Weiss, and previous YAS winners, to name a few. Judging was done in the style of 'Dancing with the Stars' with each judge commenting and awarding a number of 'stars' for each performance.

Kimmie & Adam executed Izzi's program flawlessly, and Izzi skated a fabulous solo! She received live feedback as both programs were scored. The two scores were added together for her total, and she placed 1st to win the Grassroots division! In addition to Izzi's experience of a lifetime 'skating with the stars', she received a \$1,000 scholarship, a pair of MK Revolution Blades and an opportunity to skate with Ice Theater of New York (ITNY)! **GREAT JOB, IZZI!** (For more info on YAS, visit youngartistsshowcase.net)

COCO KAMINSKI COMPETES IN THE WARSAW CUP

Coco competed at the Senior level representing Poland in her first international competition at the Warsaw Cup in Warsaw, Poland (skating up from the Junior level she competed this year). She turned in solid performances against the top skaters from 11 European countries! WAY TO GO, COCO!



Q: What was most memorable about your experience?

A (Coco): During my short program, there was a huge crowd with lots of people waving Polish flags and cheering loudly. It was so surprising and supportive. It would definitely be hard to get used to!

Q: What was most challenging about traveling abroad and competing in an international competition?

A (Coco): It was a completely different kind of competition than I was used to. There was no registration or music drop or practice ice. Of course, the language was the most challenging! But, everyone was extremely friendly and all spoke English very well so it wasn't as much trouble as I thought going into the competition.

Q: What did you enjoy most about the Polish culture? A (Coco): I loved walking around the city looking around and eating in cute bakeries.

Q: Will we see you competing internationally again anytime soon?
A: (Coco): I will be going to Bratislava, Slovakia December 19–23 for Senior Nationals. I will be competing with three other countries: Hungry, Czech Republic and Slovakia. I will also be going back to Poland in February for Junior Nationals. GOOD LUCK COCO!

Tips & Helpful Hints



Frustrated over the short life span of 'over-the-boot' tights?! How often do you purchase a new pair for a competition and discover holes after one, *and only one*, performance?! Ugh.

Well, here are a few tips to help extend their life span...

- * Mend the tights with matching colored tan all-purpose thread. For holes, sew the entire hole together from the wrong side. For runs, just sew a few stitches on both ends of the run to prevent it from spreading.
- * Place tan Band-Aids or tan skate tape (available at stores like Westwood) directly on the skate boot under where the hole will be. Or just cover the entire boot with tape for the competition. The tape can easily be removed.
- * Purchase tan colored boot covers to wear under the tights.

These are all great options that no one will notice when skaters are on the ice!

icenetwork

Icenetwork.com, a subsidiary of United States Figure Skating Association (USFS), is a website that provides ice skating news & photos, the current season's schedule of events, competition results, and event videos.

The news, photos, schedules and results portions of the website are available for free and accessible at any time. You can also find specific event times and skating order for the scheduled competitions. Scores for events are updated real-time via live feeds so results are available as they happen!

The videos are accessible with a paid annual subscription (Season Pass) that runs from Sept-Aug of each year. Subscriptions may be purchased at anytime during the year, but the USFS member discount that is offered at the beginning of each season may not apply later in the season.

Most videos are available 'on-demand' shortly after the event is concluded and can be watched an unlimited number of times at your convenience. Some of the major events are also streamed live.

Coverage includes: USFS Regionals (Juv-Sr. levels), Sectionals & Nationals, The European Championships, World Championships, The Grand Prix Series, Four Continents, and more! The subscription also includes video archives for 4 previous seasons.

Icenetwork is an invaluable resource given the limited television coverage of figure skating! It is the 'go to' place to watch thousands of videos on demand. You can follow the world's top figure skaters, and may even recognize some local faces from qualifying events! Check it out at icenetwork.com.
