Due to the increased demand, we will be adding a spring skate school session for the first time. Watch for information coming soon.



Current SQSA Parade walk-on ice, drop-in group class, exhibition and ISI testing rates are posted on the glass in the South Rink. Rates vary depending on the type and length of ice session/class and member vs. non-member status. Test rates vary by test level.

The current rates are also available on the SQSA Parade website. You can find them by selecting the Ice/Contracts/Classes menu item on the home page, and then select Rates 2014-15 Walk-on, Exhibition and Testing.
