

Tests for ISI FS8 & FS9 cannot be done at regular test sessions. Applicants must send a video of completed elements to District 10 officials. Upon approval, skaters are invited to test at an ISI competition.

The same procedure is in effect for the ISI FS10 test; however, that test must be taken at a national ISI competition. The ISI FS10 test is considered by most to be the hardest test of all USFS and ISI figure skating tests!
