Parade ice Garden is located on the edge of downtown Minneapolis with a spectacular skyline view, close to the Minneapolis Sculpture Garden and Walker Art Center, downtown, uptown, several restaurants and highways 94, 394, 100 and 35W. There is plenty of free off street parking.
