

## Requirements for being a featured skater in the SQSA Parade Ice Show April 27-29, 2012

A skater must obtain NINE or more points to be a featured skater in the Spring Ice Show. FIVE of the points come from the required list and the remaining FOUR points can be achieved by completing a combination of variable requirements listed below. In addition, featured skater must also participate in one group/production number (other than opening/closing or family number).

Competition requirements must be fulfilled from August 2011 – April 2012.

### Fixed Requirements (all 5 points must be earned):

- Full Regular Member, in good standing\* of SQSA/Parade 1 point
- Passed ISI Level 5 for Solo \*\*  
Passed ISI Level 4 for Trio \*\* 1 point  
(or Duet based on club membership seniority) \*\*
- Contract a minimum of two freestyle sessions, Sept. 6 – Feb. 28 2012 1 point
- Compete in Blades of March (3+ events) \*\*\* 1 point
- Participate in one additional ISI competition representing SQSA Parade as a solo competitor 1 point

### Variable Requirements (earn 4 or more among the following options):

- Additional ISI or USFS competitions as a solo competitor representing SQSA Parade (ISI) (one point per competition) 1 point (2 max)
- Individual entry in ISI Worlds July 2011 1 point
- Participation on SQSA Parade Team 2 points
- Additional Freestyle Contracts (after the two from the Fixed Requirements) Sept. 6 – April 30, 2012 1 point (3 max)
- High School Senior 1 point
- Full (Regular) SQSA Parade Member for 5 continuous years 1 point

\* In Good Standing is defined as being current on all payments and volunteer hour requirements. Volunteer hours must be completed or signed up to be completed by the end of the Spring Ice Show.

\*\* ISI tests must be passed at SQSA Parade or a District 10 test session by January test session. Due to the increased number of potential qualifying featured skaters, solos, duets and trios may perform in only 2 of the 3 performances **IF** the number of acts in the show causes the total show time, from start to finish, to exceed allotted show time as determined by the Show Management Committee. The Show Management Committee will determine performances. This will be determined after show entries have been tabulated, approximately two weeks after the registration deadline.

\*\*\* Medical exemption allowed only at the discretion of the Show Management Committee for registered Blades of March skater who cannot skate due to a medically verified illness.
